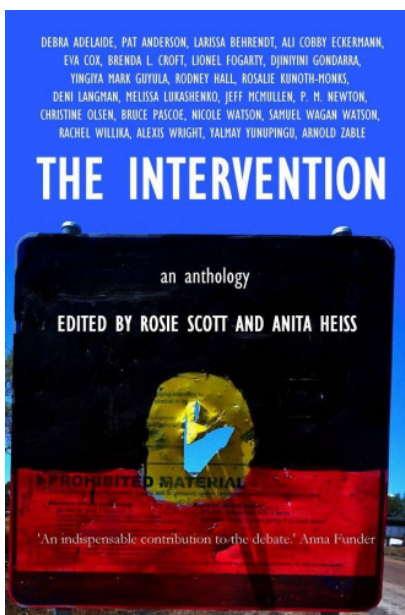


# The Intervention: An Anthology Book Launch and Forum on Ceduna, the 'Second Intervention'

## About the forum

The Adelaide launch of the Intervention Anthology coincides with what is becoming known as the 'Second Intervention.' In South Australia, Ceduna is the most recent target, with income management being made mandatory for every person of working age who receives Centrelink money. The Cashless 'Healthy Welfare Card' to be trialled in Ceduna next year will affect all Indigenous and non-Indigenous people of working age, including parents, youth, the unemployed, carers and people with a disability. The community is outraged at this blanket approach. How long before that anger ensures the most marginalised people in Ceduna become even more so?

Since the Northern Territory Intervention, income management has moved into the Adelaide suburb of Playford and the APY lands. Now a more pervasive approach is planned for Ceduna and beyond.

## Speakers

We have some amazing speakers including Kokatha (Googatha) woman and human rights activist Sue Haseldine who is at the forefront of the challenge to the second intervention in Ceduna, Kokatha academic and author Dr Dylan Coleman and social commentator Eva Cox.
